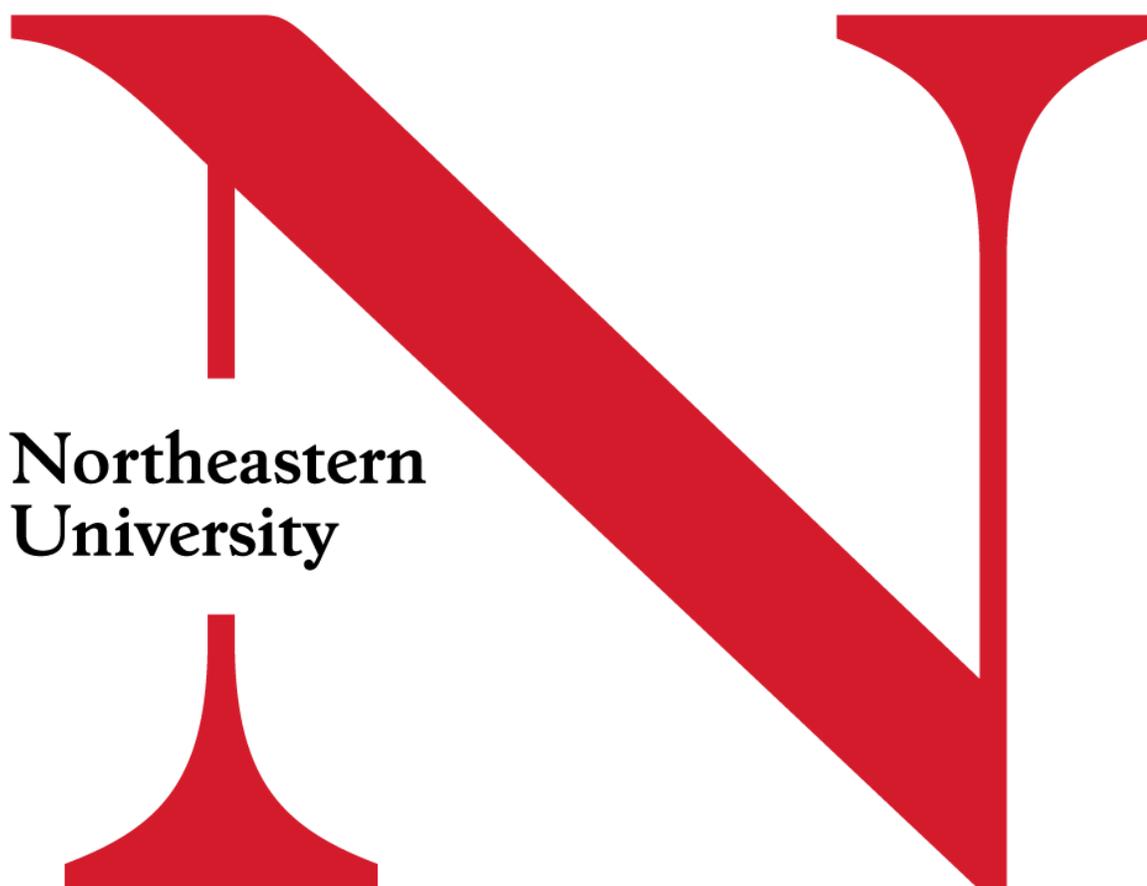

NU-RES Admin Updates

- Winter break period (December 24, 2025 - January 1, 2026).
- **Please note that proposals with sponsor deadlines falling during the break must be submitted before the break begins.** To ensure an error-free submission, **final complete proposals must be routed to NU RES by December 17, 2025.**
 - This follows our 5 full business day internal deadline guidance, which allows our team adequate time to conduct thorough reviews and address any issues before sponsor deadline.
- **If you have proposals due immediately after the break, please plan ahead to ensure adequate review time.**
- **Important: The new tuition policy goes into effect for proposals with deadlines of January 1, 2026 and beyond, so please budget accordingly.**

NU-RES Admin Updates

- **NSF Update**

- **No. 149:** Updates to NSF Research Security Policies

- As of December 2, 2025, new certifications are required at the time of proposal submission within the Cover Sheet, Biographical Sketch, and Current and Pending (Other) Support forms. These include:
 - Completion of research security training by all senior/key personnel; and
 - An institution of higher education's status regarding contracts or agreements with any Confucius Institute.
 - Organizations are required to provide supporting documentation, including copies of grants, contracts, and agreements, upon request by NSF.
 - Proposals submitted before December 2, 2025, including those submitted during the recent shutdown, are not subject to these requirements originally set to take effect on October 10, 2025.

- No. 149: Updates to NSF Research Security Policies

- Dear Colleague Letter

- Grace period for enforcement of Notice No. 149 (NSF IN-149) for proposals submitted between December 2, 2025 and December 31, 2025.

- NSF will accept proposals that include the earlier version of the Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending Support form between December 2, 2025 and December 31, 2025.

- Proposals submitted after December 31, 2025 must be fully compliant with NSF IN-149 and will be required to include latest version implemented under this policy.

NIH Update

- [NOT-OD-26-017](#): Research Security Training Requirements for NIH
 - Implementation of the Research Security Training (RST) requirements outlined in the CHIPS and Science Act of 2022 ([P.L. 117-167](#)).
 - Each covered individual (for NIH this is defined as [senior/key personnel](#)) listed on application must certify they have completed RST within 12 months of the date of application submission.
 - NIH will collect the individual certification at the time of the application submission, through the Biographical Sketch in SciENCv.
 - The AOR, via their signature on the face page of the application, will certify the applicant institution's compliance with this requirement.
 - NSF, in partnership with the NIH, DOE and DOD, have provided four online RST modules as a resource. Subsequently, the SECURE Center developed an updated and condensed version of the modules. The [condensed RST module](#) is designed to meet the government-wide RST requirements
 - **Effective Date:** At this time, the RST requirement is optional. Completion of RST and the individual and institutional certifications will be effective for applications submitted for due dates on or after May 25, 2026.

NU-RES Admin Updates

NIH Update - continued

- [NOT-OD-26-018](#): NIH's Implementation of Common Forms for Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending (Other) Support for Due Dates on or after January 25, 2026
 - Guide Notice provides details and a tables for the Common Forms, NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement, and instructions required for use for application due dates and RPPR submissions on or after January 25, 2026.
 - NIH will require MFTRP certifications from applicants and individuals identified as senior/key personnel with implementation of the Common Forms.
 - Individual Certification at the time of application: each individual identified as a senior/key person must certify on their Biographical Sketch that they are not a party to a MFTRP.
 - Annual Certification at the time of the RPPR: For awards with RPPRs submitted on or after January 25, 2026, individuals serving as senior/key personnel must certify annually to their participation or non-participation in an MFTRP by uploading a certification statement in Section G.1, Special Notice of Award and Funding Opportunity Announcement Reporting Requirements as a flattened PDF file. The file for each senior/key person must be named 'MFTRPcert_[Name].pdf' without quotations, where '[Name]' is the name of the senior/key person.
 - Effective January 25, 2026, individuals who are a current party to a MFTRP are not eligible to serve as a senior/key person on an NIH grant or cooperative agreement.

NIH Update - continued

- [NOT-OD-26-018](#): continued
 - A preview of the Biographical Sketch Common Form, NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement, and Current and Pending (Other) Support Common Form and instructions are currently available in [SciENCv](#) (see Guide Notice [NOT-OD-25-152](#)).
 - NIH will require the use of [SciENCv](#) to complete Common Forms
 - All individuals required to submit Common Forms to NIH must:
 - Obtain an Open Researcher and Contributor Identifier (ORCID iD).
 - Link their ORCID iD to their eRA Commons account.
 - Confirm their ORCID iD is displayed in the Persistent Identifier (PID) section of the Common Forms.

Can provide narrative for <i>Personal Statement</i> including information on the <i>Products Most Closely Related to the Proposed Project</i> , cited in the <i>Products</i> section of the Biographical Sketch Common Form. Field is limited to 3,500 characters.
B. Positions, Scientific Appointments and Honors	Appointments and Positions: Must only identify all domestic and foreign professional appointments and positions outside of the primary organization for a period up to three years from the date the applicant submits the application to the agency for funding consideration.	Honors: Limited to no more than 15 entries.
C. Contributions to Science: Up to 5 narrative contribution descriptions, each allowed to include citations for up to 4 products.	Products: Can provide up to 5 other significant products that highlight the senior/key person's Contributions to Science. The NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement will provide the opportunity to describe these contributions in more depth.	Contributions to Science: No citations allowed. Can provide up to 5 narrative contributions to science. Each entry is limited up to 2,000 characters. You may refer to products listed in the Other Significant Products section of your Biographical Sketch Common Form that are relevant to the contributions described in this section.

NU-RES Admin Updates

NIH Update - continued

- [NOT-OD-26-019](#): Updated Application Policies: NIH Administrative Burden Reduction Effort – Removal of Requirements for Letters of Intent and Unsolicited Applications Requesting \$500,000 or More in Direct Costs
 - Effective immediately NIH will no longer request or accept LOIs as part of the application process.
 - Applicants are encouraged to review NOFO instructions carefully as they are subject to change.
 - Effective immediately, NIH will no longer require applicants requesting \$500,000 or more in direct costs (excluding consortium F&A costs) in any one budget period to contact the funding Institute or Center (IC) before application submission.
 - Applicants are no longer required to include a cover letter identifying the Program Official contact which notes that the IC has agreed to accept assignment of the application
 - Active NOFOs containing this requirement are superseded by this Notice & will be updated going forward.
 - NIH Application Guide & Grants Policy Statement will be updated in next iteration to remove this requirement.

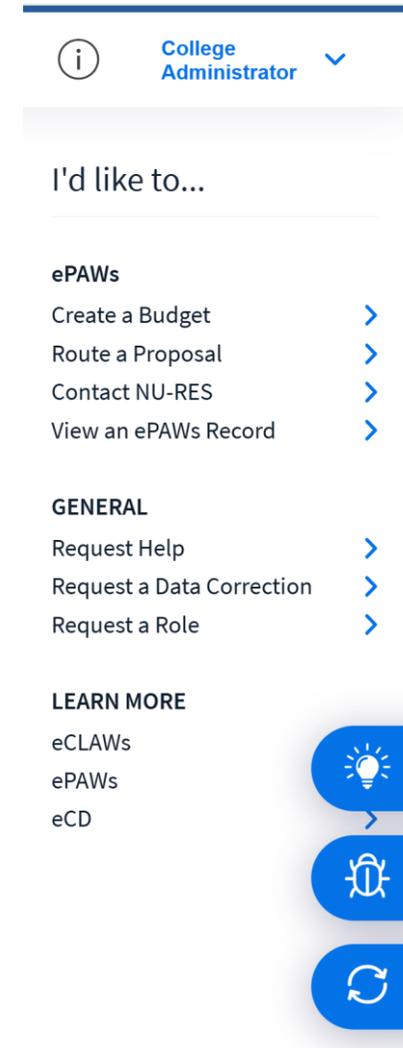

ePAWs v2.0 Launch Timeline

- ❖ **November 28, 2025:** Awards/Proposals imported to Production environment
- ❖ **December 9-12, 2025:** Finalizing transaction routes and approval routes
- ❖ **December 15, 2025:** Soft Launch Hub Clients 
 - Cross use of ePAWs 1.0 and ePAWs 2.0 - collaborative proposals
- ❖ **December 6 – February 5:** Application & System Load Feedback & Refinement
- ❖ **February 6:** NU full launch
- ❖ **February – ongoing:** Data and Reporting reviews (e.g., new data elements to be completed in legacy records, PI profiles, etc.); developing standard reports, user enhancements.

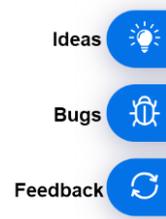

Data/Systems Updates

- EPAWs 1.0 records already submitted but still in workflow...
 - In order to process awards in ePAWs 2.0, they must be in the system as a proposal "Submitted to Sponsor"
 - First data migration occurred on 11/28/25; a second incremental migration will occur just before full launch on 2/6/26
 - As of 12/8/25...
 - 82 records still routing
 - 50 from Q2 FY26
 - 10 from Q1 FY26
 - 11 from FY25 (likely unfunded)
 - 11 from FY22-24 (probably all unfunded)
 - Senior leaders need this information to make decisions about potential future award receipts...
 - Data Team are reviewing NIH monthly for unfunded submissions to update the status in our systems...Records need to be completed in workflow in order for us to update the status

Data/Systems Updates

- ECD update
 - Annual Cycle 2025 review by Compliance Office revealed some issues with disclosure processing in eCD (system issues)
 - On 12/4, 649 disclosures were returned to the Discloser as one question was not answered and the system allowed submission for review
 - As of 12/9/26, 301 remaining
 - System issue has been permanently fixed
 - Instructions in an email notification were sent to the affected users
 - *Answer the unanswered question and resubmit*

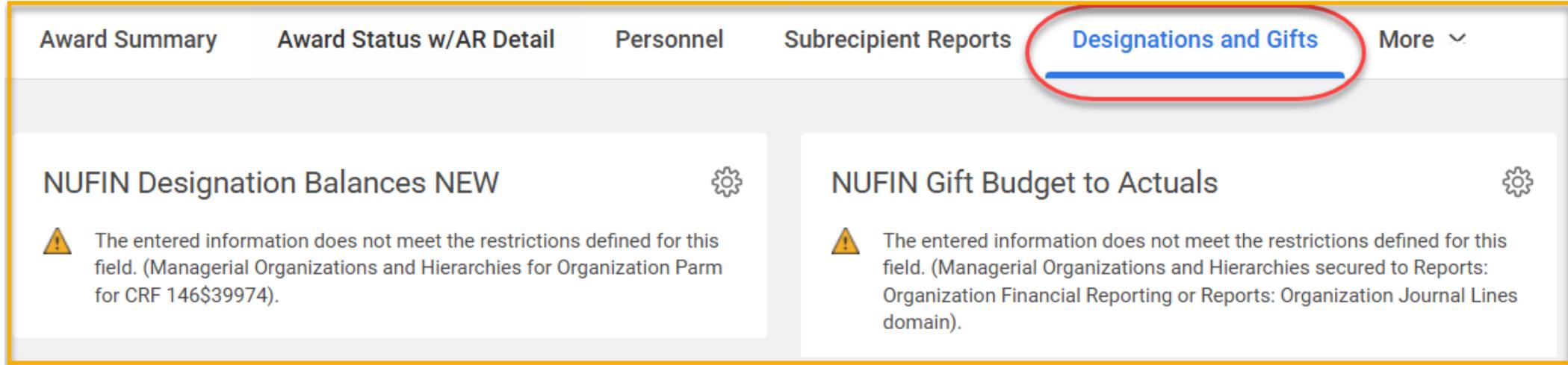

NU-RES Compliance Updates

Recent Research Security Training (RST) Policy Updates

[NSF Notice 149 Update](#)

- **Effective Date: December 2, 2025** (updated November 24, 2025)
- Research security training required for senior/key personnel on NSF proposals
- Applies to PIs with active NSF awards and those submitting new NSF proposals on or after the effective date

NIH Policy Update ([NOT-OD-26-017](#))

- **Effective Date: May 25, 2026**
- Optional implementation period until effective date
- **Northeastern requirement: Mandatory immediately**
 - Driven by Other Support requirements ([NOT-OD-25-133](#)) and compliance obligations
 - Expected approval via PI Eligibility Policy (January 2026)
 - Applies to PIs with active NIH awards and those submitting new NIH proposals

 - Research security training required for PIs with active DOE awards and those applying for DOE funding

NU-RES Compliance Updates

- Northeastern serves as the Northeast (NE) Regional Center for NSF's SECURE Center. The SECURE center works with members of the U.S. research community to create resources and tools to assist with meeting security requirements and continuing collaborative partnerships.
- The NE Regional Center has created a Foreign Travel Resource Toolkit currently housed on the SECURE website (secure-center.org). There are 4 elements to the toolkit:
 - basic travel checklist;
 - high-risk travel checklist geared towards research faculty traveling to FCOC (Foreign Countries of Concern) or working in CET (Critical and Emerging Technologies);
 - a resource guide; and
 - a sample travel briefing
