

ePAWs 2.0 – Release Notes

Release Date: June 25, 2026

Overview

This release delivers a number of bug fixes and enhancements focused on user interface improvements, proposal status management, credit split visibility, withdrawal actions, and award integration across the ePAWs 2.0 system. The updates below are organized by functional area.

Bug Fixes

Proposals

- **Proposal Status Update – Missing Required Information:** Resolved an issue where the required information needed to update a proposal status was missing, preventing the status from being updated correctly. (*NEUEPAW-16396*)

Contacts & Organizations

- **System Administrator – Error Deleting Duplicate Contacts in External Organization Hierarchy:** Fixed an error encountered by System Administrators when attempting to delete duplicate contacts within the external organization hierarchy. (*NEUEPAW-16418*)
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Improvements & Enhancements

User Interface

- **Proposal/Award Related Records – Redesigned UI:** The user interface for related proposal and award records has been redesigned to consolidate more information into a single view, making it easier to navigate and review connected records without switching between screens. (*NEUEPAW-13278*)
- **Credit Splits – Multi-Credit Split Visibility:** Investigator credit splits are now displayed directly under each investigator without requiring the user to expand an additional window, improving visibility and ease of review. (*NEUEPAW-16404*)

Proposals

- **Withdrawal Actions – Withdrawn by NU and Withdrawn by Sponsor:** Distinct withdrawal actions have been introduced, allowing NU-RES to designate whether a proposal was withdrawn by NU or withdrawn by the Sponsor, providing greater clarity on the disposition of withdrawn records. (NEUEPAW-15993)

Awards & Integration

- **New/Renewal Award Integration to Workday:** Research Finance staff can now trigger the sending of ePAWs New and Renewal Award information directly to Workday via a system integration, streamlining the award setup process. (NEUEPAW-16309)
